MAKE GRANT DECISIONS



This flowchart shows how the SFC works together to make complementary funding decisions with the goal of fully funding as many high-quality summer programs as possible each year.

SFC application period **closes**.



Baltimore's Promise **checks applications** to make sure all materials are correct then sorts the comprehensive, older youth-serving programs for youth review.



Youth review begins. Groups of youth ages 16-24 will review and score applications for comprehensive, older youth-serving programs.

At the same time, **funders begin reviewing** all applications, including those focused on younger comprehensive and specialized programs.



Baltimore's Promise **compiles youth review scores** and feedback to share with funders.



Funders use **internal review processes** to make grant decisions according to their individual organizations' priorities, taking youth review scores into account.



Funders meet to **align final decisions** with the goal of fully funding as many high-quality summer programs as possible.



Summer Funding Collaborative announces **final decisions** via email.
